Unemployment Resolution

Preventive policy for unemployment

Last period, unemployment had continuous increase and as a result of this ascendant situation caused intense concerning reflection, while have been increased also the discussions between the various institutions concerning what it should be done.

We believe that at this time there is no option for panic, but vigilance and planning for creation and application of completed preventive policy that will place on the danger fringe of further increase of unemployment.

The specific policy supposed to include:

1. Precipitation, with responsibility of government, all the developmental work in order to create new working places and maintained the employment. The constructional and tourist sector it should stand in their feet and to survive, because they constitute the lung of the Cyprus economy.
2. The immigration policy should be placed to the microscope of National Employment Committee. The responsibility of choice of suitable time belongs in the ministry of Labor and Social Insurance.
3. To intensify the efforts for cracking down illegal employment of foreigners. The dimensions of this illegality, and the creation of problems in the social funds, while already they have corroded the social structure.
In the frame of cracking down on the particular illegality, it should be increased the sentences of the employers that illegally employee foreigners, and in those who offer any other facilitations.
4. To research on upgrade of professional orientation in the schools in order to offer more and better briefing to the students for the needs of the labor market and to exists more connection of education with the professional re-establishment.

The above policy suggestion, will be supposed to deal as soon as possible with all responsible ministries of Labor and Social Insurance, Internal and Justice and with the National Employment Committee as well, which they participate all the social partners. This deal should be convened as soon as possible in order to be in place to overcome the new challenges.
